March 1st Tornado and Storms	<p>On March 1, 2017 Clermont County had a series of storms that resulted in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• EF1 Tornado in Pierce Township and the Village of Amelia</li> <li>• Straight-Line Winds in Franklin Township, Monroe Township, Tate Township, Washington Township, the Village of Neville, and the Clermont County Park District's Chilo Lock Park</li> <li>• Flooding in the City of Loveland, City of Milford, and Miami Township.</li> </ul> <p>Estimated damage to homes and business was \$1,006,330; Estimated Public infrastructure and emergency response costs were \$256,918. The damages did not meet the threshold of either the Individual Assistance Program or the State Disaster Relief Program as most homeowners and government agencies are covered by insurance.</p> <p>An After Action Meeting was held on April 20, 2017. EMA is in the process of drafting the After Action Report.</p>	
March 26th Tornado	On March 26, 2017 the National Weather Service confirmed an EF1 tornado in Williamsburg Township that impacted 3 residential structures. Estimated damage: \$53,865.	
National Preparedness Month event September 2017	September is National Preparedness Month. The committee discussed the possibility of holding another program for the local businesses similar to the 2016 event. EMA will work with the Chamber of Commerce and the Small Business Development Center on the program.	EMA will work with the Clermont Chamber of Commerce on the program.
